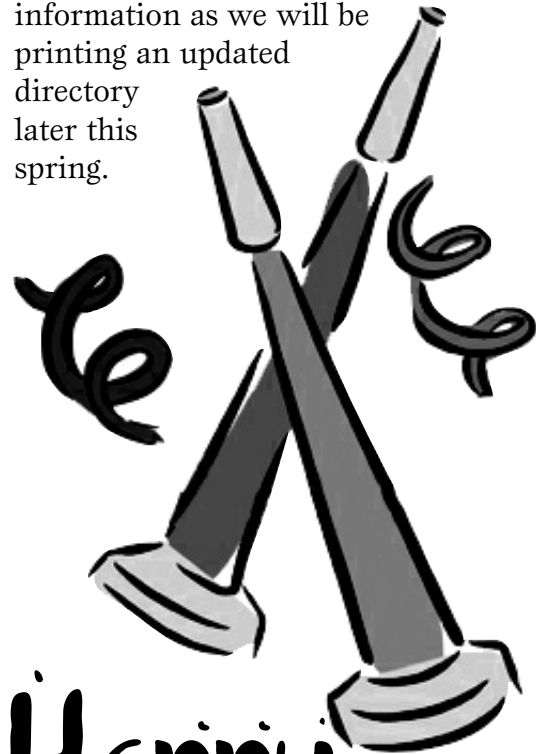

REEL NEWS *by Don Webb*
Report covers November 21 through December 19, 2005

During this period, The Northwest winds blew 14 out of 29 days, and there was basically no fishing on these days. When the boats could go out, it was excellent Yellowtail fishing, mostly around Willard Point. The water temperatures were running about 62 to 64 degrees. The following boats all brought home limits of nice Yellowtail: La Donna, Sea Dog, Susiebell, Fish Hawk, Wild Cat, Backlash, Wet Willy, Sand Dollar, Stuby Doo, Rosie, Montana, Monkey Wrench, Caroline, Whale Teaser, and

El Frigate. A combination of trolling and fast retrieving was the method used. Many 20 lb. yellowtail were caught, and even a couple of 30 lb`ers were reported.

On **Dec. 2** a boat that I'm not familiar with named Sweet Dreams was reported to have caught 4 White Sea Bass, one of which was about 50lbs.

On **Dec. 8** the Overcast boat picked up a 20 lb. White Sea Bass.

Special interest fishing reports:

On **Nov. 24** the Cardinal boat (Scotty Llewelyn, one of the founders of our club) was fishing up near Willard pt.

near shore, and trolling with steel and leaded line on the bottom. He picked up a limit of very nice Spotted Cabrilla (one weighed 18 lbs.) This is the way everyone fished here 30 years ago. It still works !

On **Dec. 17** The Goodeye, Ramona Jean, and the Mary Lou boats all brought home nice limits of Rock Bass from 14 mile reef. Capt. Myron of the Mary Lou boat caught an estimated 20 lb. Flounder or Calif. Halibut, and was bringing it up over the side of the boat without a gaff. His tackle broke, and he lossed it back into the deep. — DW
