12/27 ESCAPE went to Turner for limits of yellowtail on the troll.

12/28 - 29 ESCAPE to Pedro Matir for a few yellowtail but good catches of pinto bass, sardinera and grouper, including a golden grouper.



12/31 ESCAPE to Turner for big yellowtail. **NIGHTWINGS** to Turner and Risco Colorado for almost nothing at Turner and 4 smallish yellowtail, big goodies and a decent pinto bass at RC. 01/04 NIGHTWINGS to Christmas Tree for two halibut of 5 and 6.5 pounds on Kastmasters 01/06 SAND DOLLAR fished from Turner to Eagle's Nest for limits of bottom fish but no sign of yellowtail.

01/08 ESCAPE

fished Turner and Sea Man for limits of nice goldies.

NIGHTWINGS

jigged Turner and DeadMan for almost nothing but did manage four decent yellowtail at Risco Colorado (losing two more). **PERRYDIZE** fished San Esteban for 15 yellowtail to 20 pounds and one 10 pound sardinera. A few were caught at the lighthouse corner but



most came from the northwest corner.

01/15 JAYHAWKER and **LADY FISH** fished Turner for goldies but numbers and size were below average, except for a nice 6 pounder from **LADY FISH**. The water was rough that day.

01/16 SANDDOLLAR, WET WILLY and **NIGHTWINGS** all fished around Esteban but few, if any yellowtail were caught. Bottom fishing was okay but the winds made it very tough to fish or jig the bottom, except on the north side.

01/20 NIGHTWINGS and **TZIGINE** tried shore fishing at Christmas Tree but only caught one halibut.

The brick program will help us create a new brick pathway that leads to the club library. The current pathway is broken, uneven and in need of some love and attention.


