FINANCIAL REPORT

At the November, 2016 Monthly Board Meeting, the Board approved my recommendation to change our fiscal year from a calendar year to a seasonal year – October 1st to September 30th for comparative purposes, so that we can better analyze our operations by comparing seasons. 2017 was our year of transition, and the following financial results are based on our new September 30th year end.

Net Operating Cash Receipts from for the 12 months (October 1/16 to September 30/17) totaled \$74,700 USD.

Membership fees made up 53% of the total, while the kitchen, bar, and insurance commissions contributed 19%, 13% and 12% respectively.



Operating Expenditures for the fiscal year were \$55,300 USD. Payroll Costs accounted for 40% of the total, followed by Maintenance & Repair, Utility Costs, and Taxes. Net Charity contributions were \$3,500.

At the end of the 12 months, Cash receipts exceeded Expenditures by \$19,400.

November 24, to**

December 25, 2017.

Note: Missing dates normally mean that the wind contributed to boats not going out to fish.

I have a NEW email if you can send me any fishing news or pictures: lyncurt0@gmail.com If you can send reports by the 24th of the month, they have a better chance of being added in for the next report.

This period had a lot of periods of windy weather as the bonito fishing died down and yellowtail became less common.

11/25 PERRYDIZE fished the west side of Esteban for limits of sardinera, 5 yellowtail, and a "red fish".

11/26 SAND DOLLAR fished Turner but said it was very slow and the waves came up in the afternoon.

11/27 LADYFISH was fishing at Turner when Carrie Phillips (Jim and Darlene Lyons' daughter-in-law) from Albuquerque, NM landed a 74 pound Black Sea bass. On this day, their boat was aptly named. **SAND DOLLAR** had great weather at Turner but mostly caught bottom fish.

11/28-29 EL PATO fished Turner for lots of rockies,

small yellowtail, and sardinera.

12/3 SAND DOLLAR trolled around Dead Man mainly for big yellowtail catches. **PERRYDIZE** went back to Esteban for limits of yellowtail, 6 bonito and a sardinera. **OVERCAST** fished the south end of Turner for a good bottom fish catch and lost two "big ones".

NIGHTWINGS jigged around Dead Man mainly for bottom fish and a couple of decent yellowtail.

12/4 SAND DOLLAR braved fog, rough water and fast currents at Turner for bottom fish. **HILLBILLY YACHT** fished Esteban twice this week, once for one yellowtail and some bonito and the second trip for "lots of yellowtail" in 64-70 degree water.

12/13 NIGHTWINGS tried Christmas Tree for halibut and caught three to 5 or 6 pounds.

12/14 SAND DOLLAR trolled Dead Man for limits of yellowtail, while **DAKOTA** caught one yellowtail and bottom fish there.

12/15 NIGHTWINGS back at Christmas Tree for a couple of very small flounder with lots of birds diving on bait schools along the beach. Very slow there.

12/20 DAKOTA went to Turner for three nice yellowtail. **NIGHTWINGS** returned to Christmas Tree on a nice day for a few small halibut to four pounds. (And "one bucket" list Cortez Halibut of 23.5 pounds... picture next month).
