The season started in mid October this year, a little earlier than usual but everything went off without a hitch, we are happily anticipating the new season.



Dale Lee Kemmerer

AUGUST 11, 1933 - OCTOBER 16, 2023

ale L. Kemmerer, M.D., died on October 16, 2023, at home in Colorado Springs, CO. He was 90 years old.

Dale and his wife, Liz, who preceded him in death, were long-time Bahía de Kino residents, with a home on Avenida Mar de Cortéz. They split their time between Kino and their home in Colorado Springs, CO.

Dale was an important and much loved member of the Kino community and Club Deportivo. His kindness and care, demonstrated through dedication of his



medical and leadership skills to the Club's First Responders program for many years, touched many lives, both Mexican and ex-pat.

In addition to his service as a medical professional, Dale was a catalyst for thoughtful conversation in Kino, bringing together friends and neighbors in his home to share ideas, books, and perspectives. Dale loved nothing more than to cook up a pot of stew, or his delicious *pescado veracruzano*, to share with friends around his dining room table, along with lively discussion.

He loved going out fishing with friends, and one of his favorite memories was crossing the Atlantic as a young naval officer on the Battleship USS New Jersey.

The 2007 recipient of the Club Deportivo's Chuck McDonough Humanitarian Award, Dale was a staunch supporter of Club Deportivo as an important institution for the entire community.

Dale was an example of living life to the fullest, leading trips to Baja California and trekking the Sonoran desert and points beyond with good friends Geoff Kennedy and Bill Little, among many others. At the tender age of 90, he could play an impressive game of pickleball!

He will be sorely missed by a multitude of friends.
