Insurance may be purchased through the Club Office (in person or by telephone) or by calling Don Smith (from the USA) 1-800-258-2268 or (from Canada) 1-866-211-4735.

The best rates may be obtained by calling the Club or Don Smith's office in Nogales. Don't forget to identify yourself as a Club Deportivo member and the Club will receive a commission. The commission is only applicable when purchasing insurance by telephone or in person at the Club.

In the past, Club members who purchase Insurance through Don have enjoyed Don's generous offer to accept packages for them through his office in Nogales. While Don is still willing to receive items, **it is the responsibility of any member placing an order to arrange for the pick-up from Don's office in Nogales.** Pick up at Don's and transport to the Club is not and never has been a service offered by Club Deportivo. You may pick it up personally or make arrangements with a friend or acquaintance to pick it up from Don's. In either case you or your transporter may be required to undergo inspection of the packaged goods when crossing into Mexico and may need to pay Mexican import taxes. Additionally, the transportation of what would appear to be 'commercial goods' (packages marked UPS, FedEx, DHL, etc.) into Mexico requires a license to transport, and if you are found in violation, you may be required to return the goods to the USA.

## Don Smith Mexican Insurance

Club Deportivo is an agent for Don Smith Mexican Insurance, and as such receives a commission on Insurance sales made through the Club, or referred to Don by the Club or Club members. In Fiscal 2021, the Club's commissions from insurance sales through Don totaled \$6,400.00 USD. In order to streamline Don's and the Club's bookkeeping procedures, effective July 1, 2022, members must use a credit (or debit) card when purchasing their insurance. Payments will be made to Don Smith Insurance at the time the policy is purchased. Insurance may be purchased directly through Don via telephone, by telephone to the Club or in person at the Club office. The Club will no longer accept cash or checks to purchase insurance. Remember, Don sells Insurance to more than just Club members, so at the time you are purchasing your insurance you need to advise him or his staff, that you are a Club member, so that the Club will receive a commission.

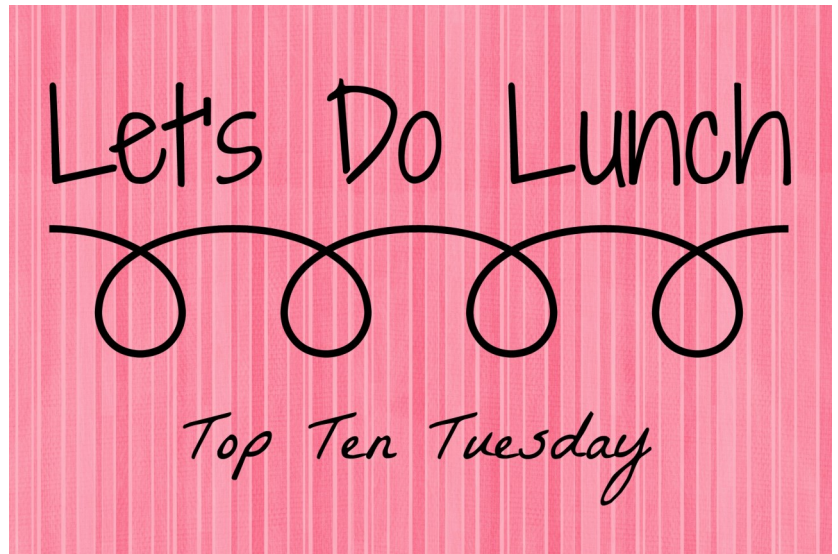
