



LOCAL RESTAURANTS:

Pargo Rojo – About six blocks east of Casa Tortuga; a nice walk on a cool evening. Good seafood, cold margaritas, and live music on weekends.

Casa Blanca – About a mile west, with a large palapa bar on the roof. Good food with a "New Mexico" style. Bar is open on Fridays and Saturdays.

Restaurant 'Jorge's' – On the beach, just before the sand ends. Good seafood and occasional specials.

La Palapa, and La Cobacha – Great location by the public 'palapa beach.' Have a cold margarita and good seafood on the outside veranda overlooking the beach and Isla Pelicano.

There are also taco stands and small eateries, too many to name, along Mar de Cortez, serving everything from fresh seafood to carne asada to cold coconuts. Some set up just for the weekend, others are regulars, others come and go!
