**Hola,

Some important things are happening in the State of Sonora.

As most of you are aware, **Club Deportivo does not own the land** our clubhouse, parking lot and storage lot sit on. We are borrowing it from the state of Sonora with a **Comadato**, which will expire in 2026. The State of Sonora, for financial reasons, has been terminating some of these comadatos before their expiration dates to sell the land.

The Board is hoping (even expecting) that we will be able to use our clubhouse for some time yet, but we have been given no assurances by the State. Beyond 2026, we should expect nothing.

Our options are few: buy the land, or move. But the price for the land is very uncertain, as is the club membership's will to purchase it. We hope the State will give us more reliable information in the near future. In the meantime, the Board will be exploring options, and discussing it with the general membership. We will possibly be having an additional General Meeting in December, or present some options at the General Meeting in February.

I want to assure you that we will work something out.

- **Rescue One**, with the repeater that extends radio contact with boats at sea, and monitors their safety, is extremely important.
- **The sense of community and camaraderie** that the club gives us, and the opportunity to make new friends is precious to us, and we will not give it up.
- **The Club's Outreach** to the Mexican Community is very important to both them and us.

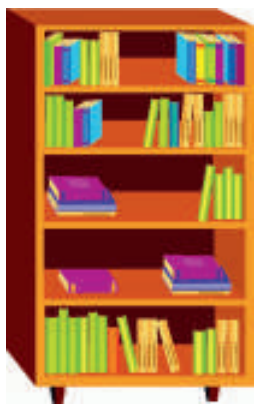
Season Pass Our board has agreed on a 'season pass' program for meals but we will postpone implementation until the 2020-21 season.
